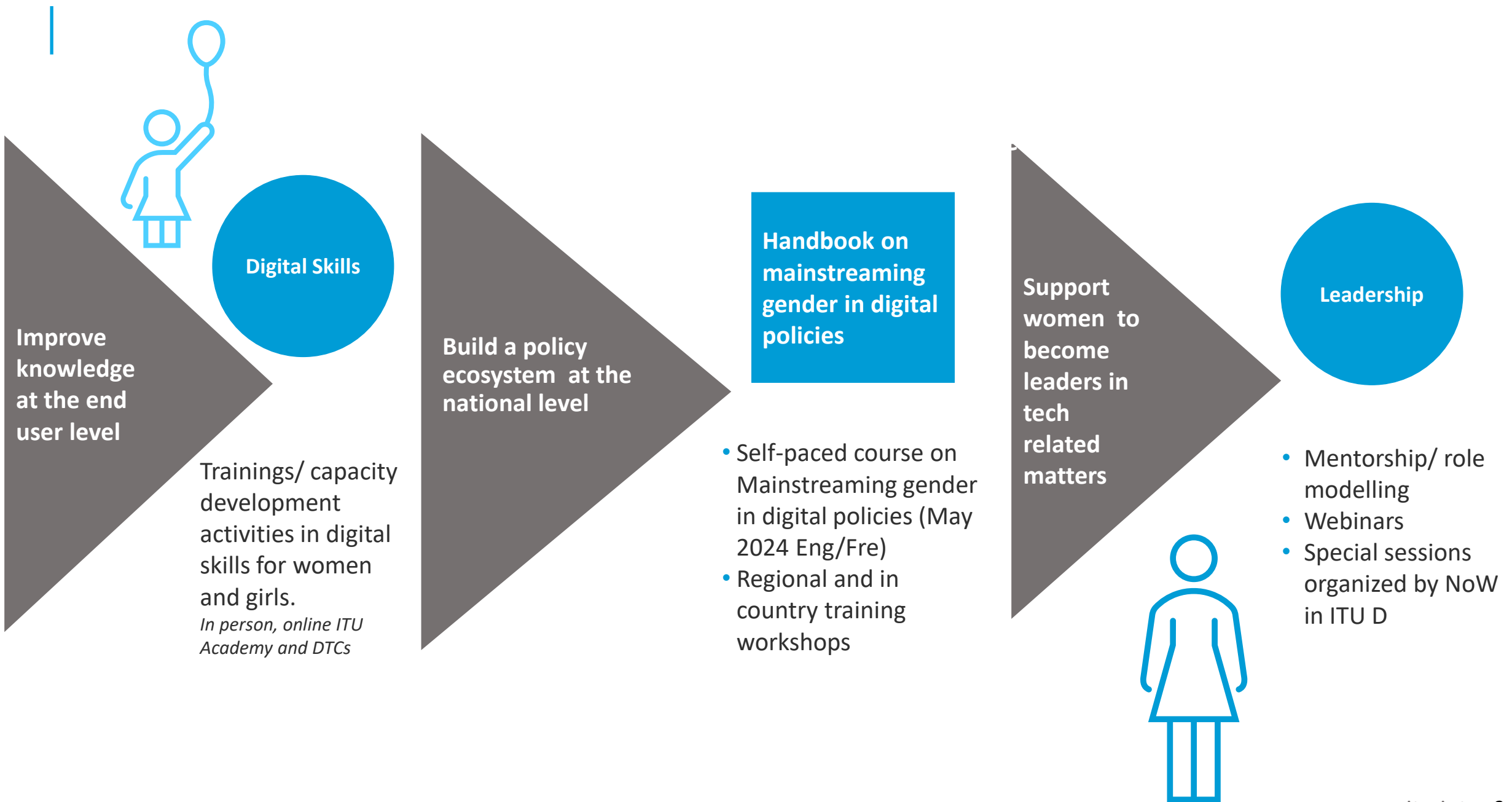

Our current offering



1. Objective – Improve knowledge at the end users level

Deliver digital skills training and certification program, through online training and hands-on STEM workshops.



- 8 foundational digital skills courses as part of ITU Academy will be released this 25th of April. These courses are designed to be gender transformative and targeted at girls and women starting 16 years old. The courses include: Tech Fundamentals, Internet Safety, Google Suite, Digital Marketing, Microsoft Office, Creative Suite, Website Development and App Development. These are all self-paced.
- Her Digital Skills Workshops: These are one-day to two-day introductory workshops for girls and young women. The curriculums are the following: Intro to AI, Intro to Cybersecurity, Intro to E-Commerce, Mobile App Development, and Web Development. To train women entrepreneurs to start or scale up their own business, to build women's capacity in digital skills and digital innovation, so as to increase their economic empowerment.

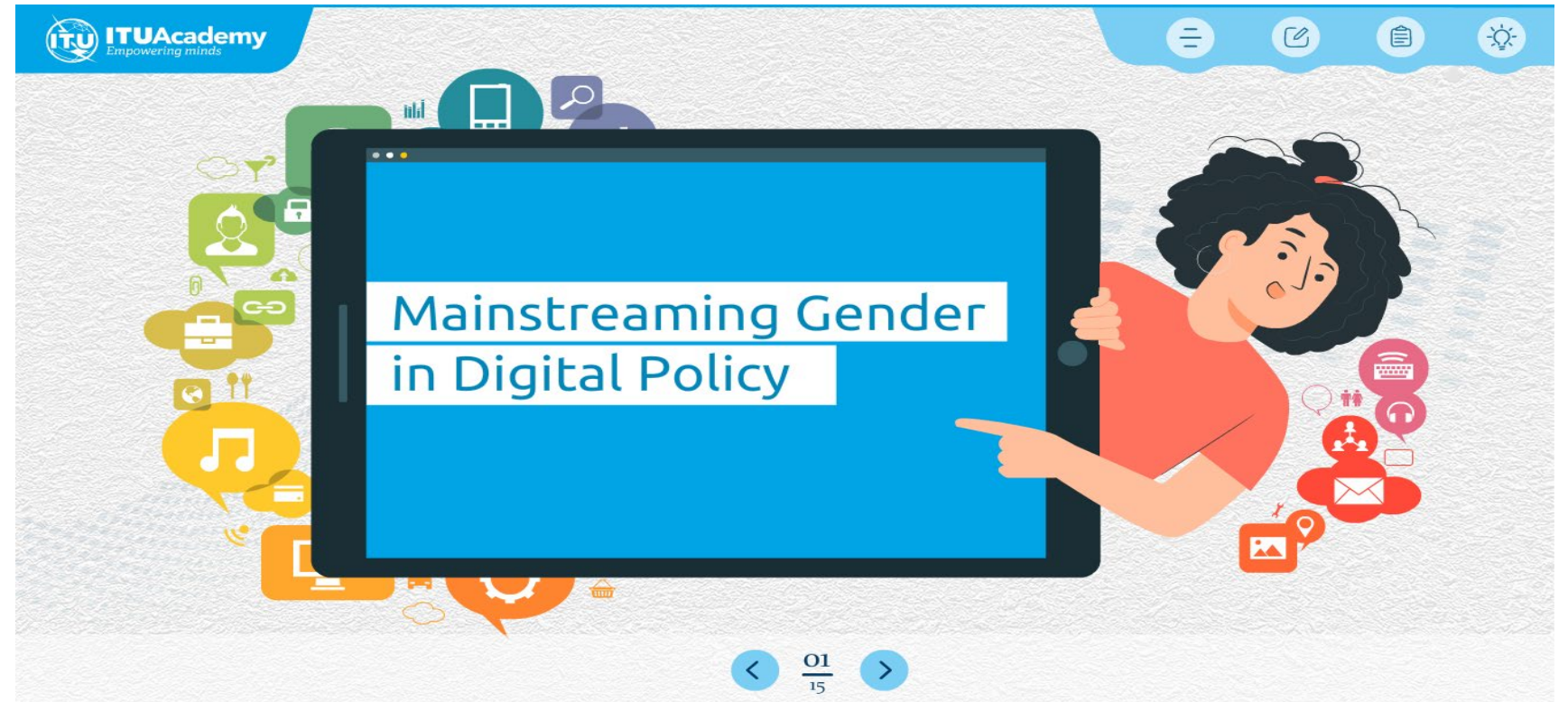

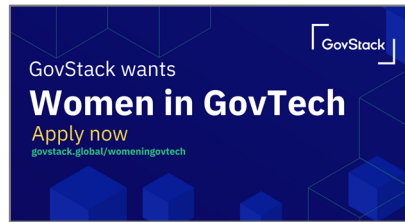
